Inspired by His Son, Boston University Professor Invents Bionic Pancreas to Manage Type 1 Diabetes



Ed Damiano, a professor of biomedical engineering at Boston University, developed the iLet bionic pancreas, a wearable device that automatically delivers insulin,

as needed, to those with type 1 diabetes. Cleared last year by the FDA, the iLet works with a glucose monitor to reduce the wearer's need to make decisions about diabetes management. Damiano worked with the Boston University Technology Development office to bring his vision to life.

University of South Florida's NEWgenerator Provides Safe Sanitation to Remote Locations



The solar-powered NEWgenerator, designed and developed by Daniel Yeh and his team at the University of South Florida (USF), provides off-grid sanitation and generates nutrients,

energy and water by safely recovering them from human wastewater. The USF Tech Transfer Office worked to ensure this technology could reach the people who need it most, negotiating non-exclusive license agreements with other countries, and partnered with organizations like the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

Gene Therapy from Nationwide Children's Hospital is First to Receive FDA Approval for Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy



Children with Duchenne muscular dystrophy (DMD), a gene mutation that causes progressive weakness and damage to muscles, have a new treatment option thanks to a

gene therapy developed at Nationwide Children's Hospital (NCH). It is the first DMD treatment to target the genetic cause of the disease as well as the symptoms. The NCH Office of Technology Commercialization helped move the therapy into clinical trials and further development.


